- **The Federal Bird-Safe Buildings Act H.R. 2280**

Introduced May 12, 2015 by IL U.S. Rep. Mike Quigley

Would require each public building constructed, substantially altered, or acquired by the General Services Administration (GSA) to meet bird-friendly standards.
